Role Purpose:

Senior Cabin Crew members are responsible for supervising the cabin crew operating on the flight to ensure the delivery of a consistently high level of safety and customer services to all passengers. To present a caring and courteous manner to ensure that passengers have a first-class experience on Aurigny flights.

Key Accountabilities:

- Ensures full and up to date knowledge of the Aurigny Air Services product and all aspects of the job and duties, i.e. safety, first aid, security, service, procedures and customer service skills
- Give a comprehensive pre-flight briefing to all cabin crew members operating. Ensuring that uniform regulations are conformed with and correcting where necessary
- Is responsible to expedite service, PA, safety and security checks, passengers' first aid requirement and ensure passengers safety and comfort throughout the flight by ensuring continuous monitoring of the cabin
- Performing safety related duties as laid down in the company operations manual
- Maintaining discipline during the flight, ensuring cabin crew adhere to the in-flight
 procedures applicable to the aircraft type. Complying with the inflight service applicable to
 the route to be operated
- Liaising with the flight crew ensuring crew communications is effective and efficient
- Completing all necessary paperwork
- Managing the catering equipment once it has been loaded on board the aircraft
- Taking overall responsibility for the smooth running of the flight, complying with the inflight service applicable to the route being operated. Monitoring the service standards being achieved, correcting crew where necessary
- Motivating cabin crew and leading by example
- Provide constructive feedback to Aurigny Air Services management regarding the onboard product.
- Be professional always, particularly whilst in uniform, and behave in a manner as expected
 of an Aurigny employee, whether on base or away from base for flying duties. Ensuring that
 the image and reputation of Aurigny is always safeguarded.
